Form of Undertaking for a Junior City Scholar.

Before a pupil can be admitted to the Secondary School, the Form of Undertaking overleaf must be signed over a sixpenny stamp by the parent or legal guardian of the child. A copy of the form should be retained by the parent for future reference. The signed and stamped undertaking must be returned to the Director of Education, 14, Sir Thomas Street, Liverpool, 1.

UNDERTAKING BY PARENT (OR GUARDIAN).

I declare the foregoing particulars to be correct, and I hereby undertake to observe the conditions and regulations laid down by the Liverpool Education Committee or Governing Body of the School to keep my son (daughter) at a Secondary School for at least four years, and covering his (her) sixteenth birthday,* viz. :—until..... and in the event of the further renewal of the Scholarship for the full period of such renewal, and to ensure that he (she) shall conform to the rules and regulations of the School for the time being in force, including regulations as to home work, and I agree to withdraw him (her) from the school only at the end of a school term, and to give notice of withdrawal in writing to the Headmaster (Mistress), six clear weeks before the end of the term.

In default of the due performance of the above undertaking or any part thereof, without the consent of the Committee or Governing Body previously obtained, I agree to pay to the Committee or Governing Body a sum equal to the amount of the school fees remitted (if any), for the period during which the Scholarship has been held, including fee in lieu of notice if due notice has not been given, together with the cost of any further assistance which may be provided for him (her) by the Education Committee in respect of the period during which the Scholarship has been held, or such less amount as may be fixed, such amount to be recoverable as liquidated damages.

† The Signature of the Father or legal Guardian is required.

*NOTE.—Where a Pupil is admitted at the age of Twelve or over, he is required to remain at the Secondary School for a Course of Four Years. If he is below the age of Twelve, then he will be required to attend a Secondary School until the end of the School Term during which he attains the age of Sixteen.
