

Harold Williams in the editorial article of the School's Centenary Magazine wrote "In estimating the worth of any school it is futile to enumerate the successes of one year or of one period . . . . It is misleading merely to count up the open scholarships and great successes won by its pupils . . . . It may arouse enthusiasm and effort in the boys of the Institute to hear that an Old Boy was awarded a Nobel Prize but to assess the full value to the community what is needed is some estimate of the effect on each boy turned out year by year and that calls for a calculus beyond our best mathematicians. Only old pupils looking back on their school life and seeing the effect on their own minds and characters and multiplying that effect by thousands can come somewhere near the truth."
